

Dubai is located on the Eastern coast of the Arabian Peninsula, in the south west corner of the Arabian Gulf. It is extremely well known for its warm hospitality and rich cultural heritage, and the Emirati people are welcoming and generous in their approach to visitors. With year-round sunshine, intriguing deserts, beautiful beaches, luxurious hotels and shopping malls, fascinating heritage attractions and a thriving business community, Dubai receives millions of leisure and business visitors each year from around the world.

The local currency is the dirham, which is pegged at AED 3.67 to 1 US dollar. Dubai is tolerant and cosmopolitan and all visitors are welcome. However, Islam is a way of life in the city, and therefore tourists should adopt a certain level of cultural and religious sensitivity for the duration of their stay.

Dubai has a warm, sunny climate that is ideal for tourism, with mild temperatures for most of the year and a low rainfall. Summer temperatures in July and August can reach highs of around 45°C (113°F) with high humidity, making this the least comfortable time of year to visit in terms of climate. However, Dubai is well geared up for high temperatures, and public transport, shopping malls, hotels, restaurants and visitor attractions are all air conditioned.

English is widely spoken in Dubai, and as all restaurant menus, road signs and other information is usually presented in both English and Arabic, visitors who speak English will have no trouble making their way around. Many tour operators and travel professionals will also be able to offer services to French, Russian and German speaking visitors.

Dubai City Tour





Learn about Dubai's rich colourful traditions and history on this city tour which allows you to experience both the ancient and modern in this desert paradise.

Despite being one of the most modern cities in the world, Dubai still retains much of its original character that is colored with the globally renowned creek, ancient sailing dhows and wind towers of the old Arab homes in the Bastakiya District. Visitors are taken to the Al Fahidi Fort Museum, which throw light on Dubai's historical links with trading and pearl diving.

Enjoy pickup in from your centrally located Dubai hotel and relax in your comfortable, air-conditioned vehicle on the way to your first Dubai city stop, the striking sail-shaped Burj Al Arab hotel. Located on the sands of Jumeirah Beach, on an artificial island, this luxury hotel is the fourth tallest in the world, at 1,053 feet (321 meters).

Stop for a photo opportunity, and then continue with your guide along the shoreline to Jumeirah, one of Dubai's upmarket residential areas. See the winding lanes that lead to hidden courtyards and the mud-brick homes topped by traditional wind towers, designed to catch cooling offshore breezes. Next, visit Al Bastakiya's old Al Fahidi Fort, home to the Dubai Museum, and take in views of the cannons, turrets and fortified walls.

Then cross Dubai's central waterway, Dubai Creek, in a traditional water taxi called an abara – a must-do activity in Dubai!

Abu Dhabi City Tour





Commonly referred to as the Manhattan of the Middle East, Abu Dhabi city offers a perfect blend of modern and Arabian architecture. Tourist will find a lot of fascinating sites including the Heritage Village, the world renowned Emirates Palace hotel and the beautiful Corniche which offers breathtaking views of the city's skyline, Al Hisn Fort, Old Souk and the Breakwater Island.

The tour will also pass the presidential palace, the Dhow yard and Batinah harbour, where the traditional wooden boats are made.

You continue to the city through the well laid out roads, surrounding lush greenery, beautiful parks, and rows and rows of trees until you reach Abu Dhabi's oldest building, Al Husn Palace built in the 18th century, then visit Abu Dhabi's Sheikh Zayed Grand Mosque.

Enjoy a magnificent view of the city by driving along the beautiful Corniche and make a photo-stop at the Breakwater. We then visit the Heritage Village and journey to the past to explore the life before oil was discovered.



Sharjah & Ajman City Tour





This guided tour of Sharjah city offers visitors an alluring array of historical mosques and old souks that reflect true Arabian grandeur. The famous Al Rolla Square and impressive Central souk houses shops etched in Arabian architecture.

Visitors will be treated to views of the majestic King Faisal Mosque, the Pearl Monument, symbol of the UAE Federation and the fabulous Blue Souk, where more than 600 shops sell carpets, gold, silver, antiques, perfumes, clothes and many other goods which offer a good deal for bargain hunters.

In Ajman, visitors are greeted by beautiful beaches and the famous Ajman museum. The Central Souk offers visitors typical Arabian architecture and hundreds of shops.



Al Ain City Tour





Al Ain city – popularly known as the 'Garden City' – is a desert oasis surrounded by striking golden sand dunes and beautifully shaped hills. The city houses many artifacts from an Iron Age village discovered in Al Hili, items from ancient burial sites near Jebel Hafeet and other items unearthed in Qattara which date back to 3,000 BC.

Jebel Hafeet which rises 1,350 feet provides spectacular views across the border between the UAE and Oman. A modern three lane highway lit by yellow halogen streetlamps snakes up the mountain to the royal palace and picnic areas at the top.

The tour will also take visitors to the numerous farm lands and provide an opportunity to catch a glimpse of the farmers and their ancient irrigation system in addition to the traditional camel market.



Fujairah City Tour





Fujairah lies on the east coast and offers visitors a variety of landscapes including miles of pristine sandy beaches. Visitors are treated to a refreshing swim in the India Ocean. The tour also includes numerous water sports like yachting, surfing diving and deep-sea fishing.

A ride across the city will give tourists breathtaking views of the wadis, mountains and the deep blue sea. There is also a stop at the popular Friday market and the Biddiya Mosque – the oldest mosque in the UAE.
